The featured project is a collaboration between Entanglements and Paal Grant Design. The owners of the home desired an artistic summer room to complement their pool and garden.

The 'Kuru' laser-cut pattern from Entanglements' range has been used in the pagoda poles. Entanglements' bolt table and stools have also been incorporated.

Measuring 3m x 3m, the summer house is crafted from Corten rust and features LED strip lighting and a roof planter.
